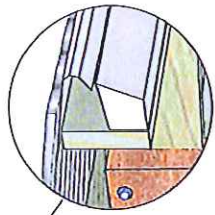

# Curved Roof Shelter

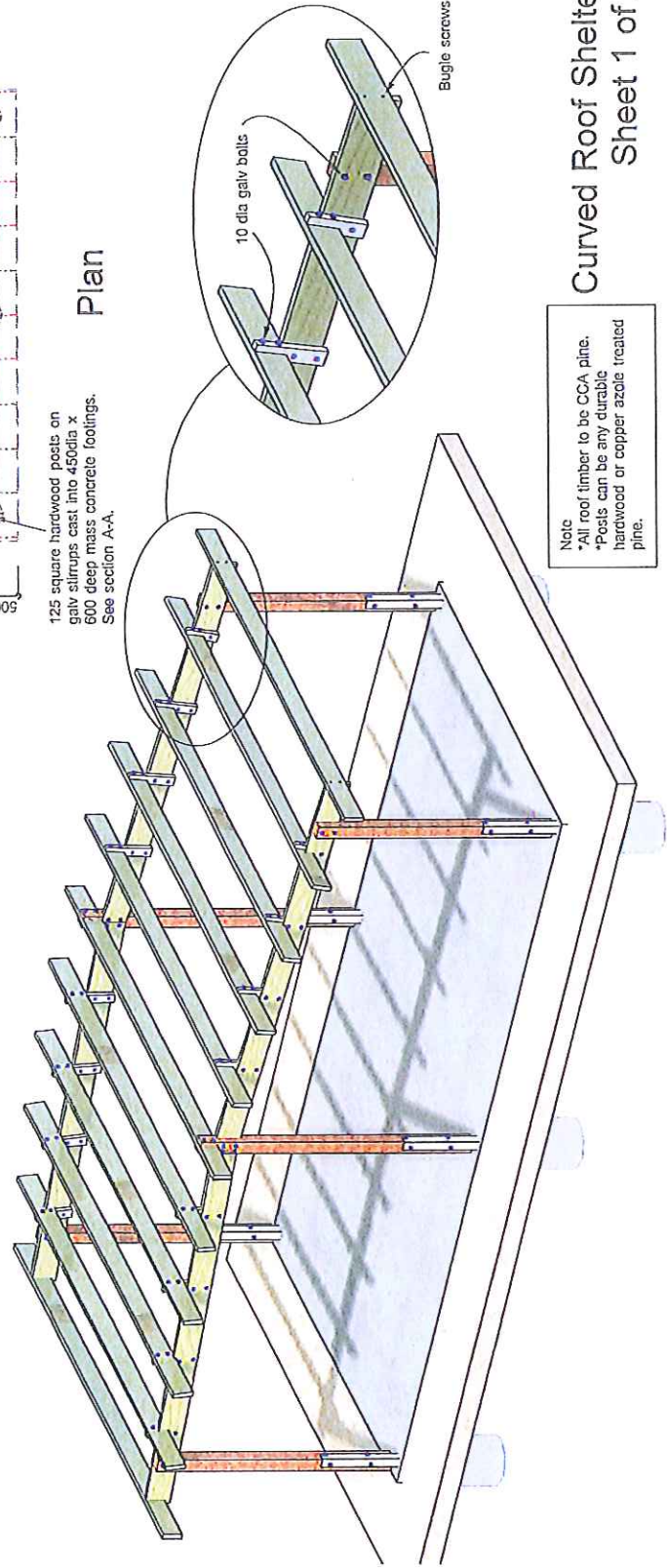
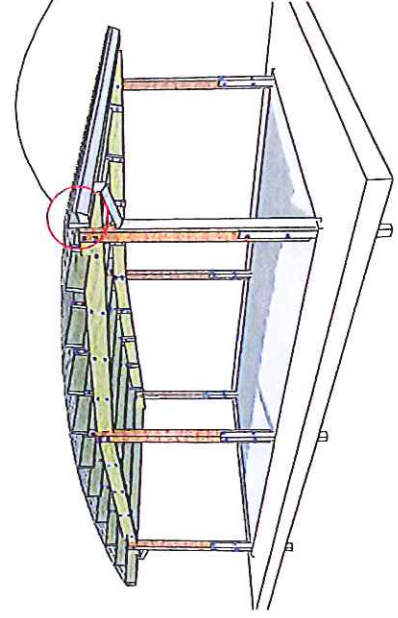


Plan

125 square hardwood posts on galv stirrups cast into 450dia x 600 deep mass concrete footings. See section A-A.



Leaf free gutter. See details
